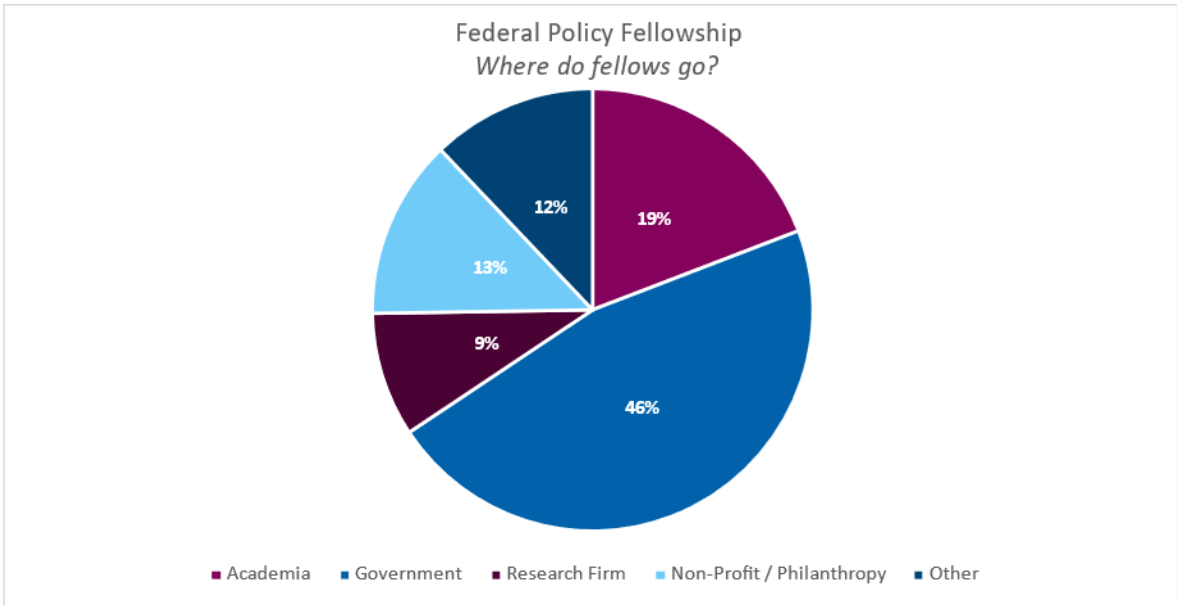

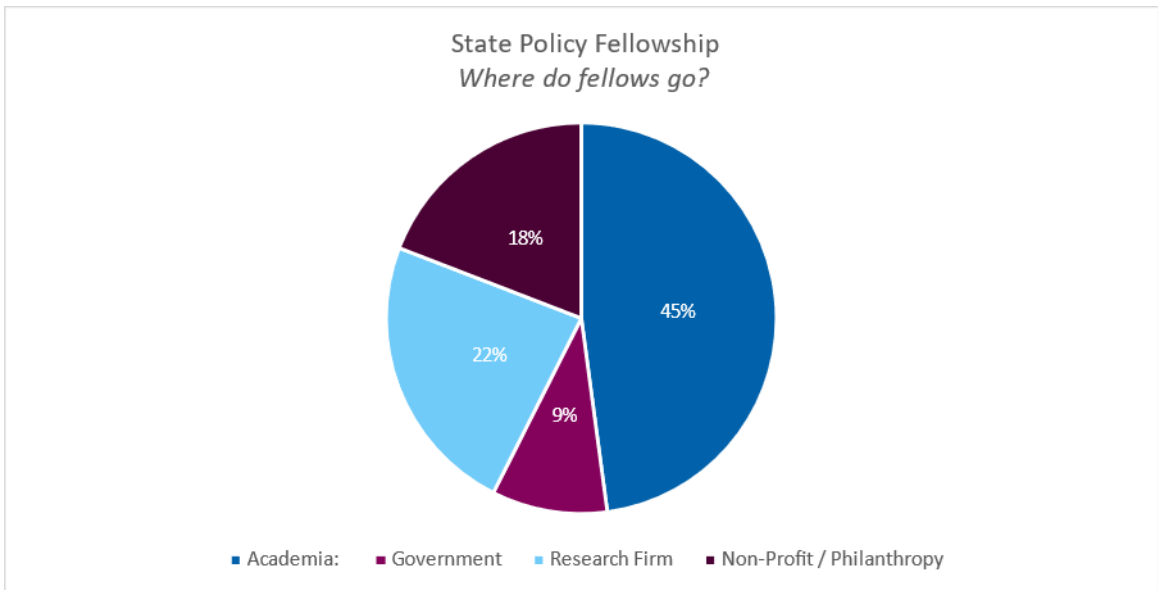

In that time, almost 70% have remained in policy-relevant roles, including in government, nonprofits, philanthropy, or research firms. We like to joke that we're slowly infiltrating the policy world. But we know that we're achieving one of our main program goals – we're building a network of experts with the necessary research and policy skills to bridge developmental science, state policymaking, and practice.
