I am delighted to inform you that the Final Report of the Task Force on Publications and Ethical Behavior is now available, along with a memorandum from the Governing Council that summarizes its responses to the thoughtful recommendations presented in the Task Force report. As the memorandum from the Governing Council indicates, several of the Task Force's recommendations have already been implemented or are in the process of being implemented. An Implementation Task Force will be formed to prioritize and identify clear plans for implementing several of the other recommendations.
